6(1) 1. Littlechild & Bridgewater's Ravensett Fire 'n' Ice. Lots to like about this quality 16 mths orange male. Beautiful head, masculine without coarseness, with low set ears and dark eye, giving a soft, gentle expression. Flowing outline, well balanced throughout with good angulation. Moved positively, using his tail.

2. Taylor's Wansleydale Bellini. Lovely headed 15 mths orange female, with dark eyes and excellent pigmentation. Short coupled. Strong quarters, giving excellent movement. Tail well set on. 3.

Radbrooks Sloop JohnB.

The Jack Bowen MBE Open Memorial Award.

18(6) 1. Tompsett's Radbrooks Kokomo. Mature dark blue female of good make and shape. Pleasing feminine head and soft expression, with dark eyes. Good forehead and rear quarters, balanced throughout. Moved soundly. 2. Hartle's Hartsett All My Lovin. Pretty orange female, lovely head with dark eyes and kind expression. Good reach of neck. Excellent bone and substance. Moved steadily, but carrying a little too much weight today. 3. Beechanger Dusty Miller.
