

# **IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR EXISTING OR ASPIRING**

## **'C' LIST JUDGES OF ENGLISH SETTERS**

With effect from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019 there will be the first changes about who can judge what classes under the Kennel Clubs' new Judges Competency Framework (JCF) process.

What does this mean? If a C List judge (who doesn't already award CCs in another breed) wants to continue judging after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019 they must satisfy the following KC requirements;

1. The mandatory requirements for JCF Level 1 are;
  - a) Have a proven interest of a minimum of 5 years in one or more aspects of breeding and exhibiting of pedigree dogs (including stewarding and administration)
  - b) Undertaken 6 full days of stewarding appointments
  - c) Attended and passed a KC Requirements of a Dog Show Judge (RDSJ) exam
  - d) Passed the KC Points of the Dog assessment
  - e) Attended a KC Conformation and Movement seminar
  - f) Completed and passed KC Critique Writing seminar and exam (will be available online after its launch at Crufts 2018)
  
2. Join the KC Academy and register at JCF Level 1

If any of the above JCF Level 1 requirements are not satisfied, then people not on a B List or above will only be able to register at the JCF Entry Level which does not allow them to judge after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2019.
