MPD (2) 1. Williams' Richecca Midwinter. 6½ month tri. Good head and eye, well constructed with good body properties, very good front, bone & feet. A pleasing outline with strong topline and good tailset. Strong well angulated hindquarters moved and showed well. Very promising.

JD (1) 1. Wilkinson's Phensett Firestorm. 15 month O/B. Upstanding with well developed body and good spring of rib. Good shoulder placement, strong topline, strong short coupled loin and strong well angulated hindquarters. Sound positive mover showed well and in good coat.

YD (5) 1. Schoneville & Derry's Balvenie Blue Sensation. B/B, masculine head, well constructed with good front, bone and feet. Pleasing Outline with good topline and tailset, well developed body, strong loin and well angulated hindquarters, showed well in good coat. 2. Hepburn's Tattersett Rainbow Legacy. O/B handsome 19 month well constructed, very good shoulder placement giving a very good forehand. Good front, bone and feet. Good body and strong loin. In good coat, very good mover front and rear. 3. Ciaputa's Wansleydale Skyfall.

ND (2) 1. Kelly's Edge Of Dreams at Archenset. Tri colour 2 years, Handsome well grown. Well balanced with a good outline. Strong topline and good tailset, good front assembly, strong short, coupled loin, and well angulated hindquarters, moved soundly. 2.

GD (6) 1. Owen's Cornsett You My Everything. O/B mature male with a very good head and eye, excellent forehand, good front, bone and feet. Lovely outline, standing on strong well angulated hindquarters. Moved with reach and drive, accurate front and rear and in lovely coat and show condition. 2. Bishop's Dyrham Desert storm. Close up to winner. Handsome O/B upstanding, also a lovely outline strong topline and good tail set. 3. Wilson's Ravensett Giovanni

PGD (8) 1. Normansell's Latin Lover Rewind For Larrenie (Imp ITA). B/B Upstanding with good head and eye, super outline. Very good legs, bone and feet, strong topline and good tailset, standing on strong sweeping hindquarters, in full coat. Ground covering stride with very good front reach and drive and a lot of ring presence. 2. Bryant, Bryant and Hollis Silvamoon Stormtrooper For Phenset. Tricolour well made throughout, very good front, bone and feet. Good forehand stronger in head, short coupled loin, good body properties. Rather low in tailset, well angulated hindquarters. Moved soundly but could be more positive in hind action today. 3. Lawson's Wansleydale Dorian Gray.

LD (6) 1. Danks-Kermish's Ravensett Work Of Art At Alolfrana. Dark O/B Handsome male with a very good head and eye, lovely outline. Well constructed with very good body properties, well balanced throughout. In full coat moved well with lovely carriage and good reach and drive. Pleased to award him the dog CC and later Best In Show. 2. Harris, Bridgewater and Hoeksema's Bridgella's First Edition with Konakakela. Pressed hard, lovely head and eye. Very pleasing outline, strong topline and good tailset. Well constructed throughout and has matured in body. Standing on strong, well angulated hindquarters, sound active mover. Both dogs displaying very good breed type. Res DCC. 3. Phillips, Bryant and Watkins Glenmaurangi Star Man.

OD (4) 1. Taylor & Atteo's Samelen Harris Tweed. O/B mature dog with good head and eye. Upstanding with good overall balance, good forehand, strong topline and good tailset. Strong well angulated hindquarters. Moved soundly with good carriage. 2. Kelly's Alolfrana Memphis Rock, Tri colour with a pleasing head and eye, good front bone and feet. Strong topline and good tailset. Well constructed, strong short coupled loin and well angulated hindquarters. In good coat and condition. Good front action but tending to pull sideways in rear action.

MPB (6) 1. Kelly's Richecca The Snow Queen. 6½ mths O/B. Lovely head and eye, super outline, well constructed with excellent body, front, bone and feet. Well angulated hindquarters, strong topline and good tailset. Sound positive mover, Best Puppy in Show. 2. Sharples' Kanietter Viennese Whirl. Tri with very feminine head and good eye. Well constructed, not quite the body properties of the winner. Well let down in brisket, good spring of ribs, strong topline and good tailset. Well angulated hindquarters, moved soundly. 3. Cook's Pernickety Soliloquy.

PB (2) Cook's Pernickety Soliloquy. O/B 3rd in previous class. Pleasing head and eye, well constructed but not the bone of the other two. Good outline, strong topline and good tailset, strong loin. A sound and confident mover.

VB (2) 1. Stephenson's Lakecastle Kasumi At Wistaston, Tri with a lovely head and eye, well constructed throughout, excellent front, bone and feet. Very good forehand and shoulder placement, strong topline and good tailset. Strong well angulated hindquarters. Very sound positive mover in good coat and show condition. Best Veteran in Show. 2. Hartle and Stone's Hartsett All My Lovin. O/B with a pleasing head and eye. Well constructed with good bone and body properties. Strong well angulated hindquarters in very good coat and condition. Not quite as positive in hind action as winner.

JB (2) 1. Danks-Kermish's Mandysset Fame and Fortune At Alolfrana. B/B 16months, feminine head, good eye, pleasing outline and well constructed. Needs a lot more body development, strong topline and good tailset. Well muscled and angulated hindquarters, moved well with good carriage.

YB (5) 1. Owen's Beechanger Isabelina At Cornsett. O/B well developed body, good front, bone and feet. Could be more feminine in head. Good outline, strong topline and good tailset. Good depth of chest, strong well angulated hindquarters, moved soundly with correct tail carriage. 2. Dobbies Tattersett Swiss Storm At Suthron. B/B very feminine head, good eye, pleasing outline. From a finer mould, well constructed throughout, well angulated hindquarters, sound positive mover.

MB (1) 1. Tompsett's Leilasett Northern Lights Over Radbrooks. 18 month O/B, pleasing head and eye, well, constructed front assembly. Good shoulder placement, strong well angulated hindquarters. Not in coat today, very good front action when moving but could be more positive behind.

GB (3) 1. Jones' Alolfrana N'All that Jazz. O/B very pleasing head and eye, well constructed with a good front, bone and feet. Strong topline and good tailset, good body properties, not in her best coat. Sound mover but could be more animated.

PGB (7) 1. Colton's Rowanmyle Gude Blue Bonnet Ennydloc. B/B pleasing head and eye, well constructed throughout, very good shoulder placement. Well let down in brisket, good spring of rib and short coupled, strong loin. Strong well angulated hindquarters, moved very soundly holding her topline on the move. A very good tail carriage and action. 2. Beasley's Wansleydale Amaretto. Lovely head and eye, very elegant with a very good outline. Well balanced throughout, in very good coat and show order. Sound active mover but not as positive in hind action as winner. 3. Pitts' Wandsfell Dream Maker

LB (9) 1. Grimsdell's Tattersett Lucerne, B/B very feminine head and good eye. Well balanced with a strong topline and good tailset. Well constructed throughout and well let down in brisket. Very good front assembly, strong short coupled loin and well muscled hindquarters. In good coat and condition. Moved very well with positive action front and rear. Pleased to award her the bitch CC and Reserve Best in Show. 2. Dennis, Harris and Morgan's Gemsett Ice Cold In Alex At Mariglen. O/B upstanding with a pleasing head and eye, well constructed with a good forehand and a pleasing outline. Good hind angulation a good tailset and carriage, sound mover but not putting all in today. In good coat and show order Res. CC. 3. Bryant, Bryant and Hollis Phenset Sparks Will Fly.

OB (3) 1. Cook's Bridgella's Sophie Loren At Penickety. O/B with a good head and eye. Would like a little more height and reach. Pleasing outline and strong topline. Well-developed body, strong loin and well angulated hindquarters. Sound mover with good tail action. 2. Grimsdell's Tattersett Clever Cookie. O/B upstanding bitch with a lovely head and eye, very well balance and constructed throughout. Excellent body properties, strong hindquarters. In good coat and show condition. Not moving at her best today.
