Please see the latest KC press release regarding JCF Hands-On Judging Experience. This needs to be read in conjunction with the other JCF Updates issued on 12th February and 24th February.

Let me know if you can't open the link or want any further information.

To be clear, English Setters are in Stud Book band C and it is proposed to increase the hands-on requirement for the current judging system to from 110 to 120, and to reduce the hands-on to 60 for anyone going down the new JCF system to get onto Level 3.

Another change to our current criteria is that the KC is now allowing hands-on numbers from overseas appointments to be counted!
